The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.0432 dated 13.11.2015, registered at Police Station East Sector-26, Chandigarh, under Sections 279 and 337 IPC and Sections 3 and 181 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, on the basis of compromise dated 11.12.2015 (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to orders dated 29.02.2016 and 17.05.2016, reports dated 17.08.2016 and 26.07.2016 have been received from the Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chandigarh and the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chandigarh, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and FIR No.0432 dated 13.11.2015, registered at Police Station East Sector-26, Chandigarh, under Sections 279 and 337 IPC and Sections 3 and 181 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, alongwith all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, is quashed.
