The instant writ petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to respondents No. 1 to 6 to conclude the enquiry/investigation into the matter and to take appropriate action as per law against Respondent Nos. 7 to 8 and further protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at their hands and seeking a direction for the representation dated 18.06.2018 to be decided expeditiously.

It is contended that no legal proceedings have been initiated against respondent Nos. 7 to 8, who are the main persons involved. It is further contended that the petitioner has been approaching the respondents time and again and has submitted representation dated 18.06.2018, which

has further marked for enquiry to the SSP Patiala and a copy for the same was also sent to Home Secretary. The Home Department also sent a letter dated 03.07.2018 to the DGP Punjab. But no action has been taken against respondent No. 7 and his brother-respondent No.8 and again the representation of the petitioner was recommended to file the complaint vide report dated 13.07.2018 but no action was taken. The true translated copy of the complaint dated 18.06.2018, letter dated 03.07.2018 and report dated 13.07.2018 are attached herewith as Annexures P-7 to P-9 respectively.

Learned counsel also contended that on dated 06.08.2018 the petitioner visited the office of DGP Punjab and narrated her grievances to the DGP and a representation was also submitted then and there which was marked to IG Patiala vide letter No. 3271/SO/DGP dated 06.08.2018 and further the IG Patiala forward the same to SSP Patiala but till date no action has been taken. Learned counsel urges that the representation should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Ms. Rajni Gupta, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioners within a period of six weeks, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 18.06.2018 of the petitioner within a period of six weeks from the date of

receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
