The grievance of the petitioner is that his child died in the womb of the mother on account of the negligence of respondent No.4. Despite complaints Annexures P2 to P4, the police has failed to take any action.

Notice of motion.

Mr. D.R. Singla, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent No.4, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation dated 18.09.2018 (Annexure P3) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

It is further directed that immediately on receipt of this order, respondent No.2 shall depute a person to visit the concerned hospital so that CCTV camera footage of the date of occurrence may be preserved in case it has not already been deleted.
