Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in complaint case bearing No.COMA/29213/2013 dated 17.09.2013 titled as “Nirmal Singh Versus Gurpal Singh” under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 filed against the petitioner by respondent No.2-complainant, wherein the petitioner has been declared as a proclaimed person by the trial Court vide order dated 05.03.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and to face the trial, which is at an advance stage of hearing.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the fact that the trial in the case is at an advance stage of hearing, the present

petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of one week and moves an application for regular bail, the trial Court shall make an endeavour to decide the same within two days from the date of such application.
