This order shall dispose of the aforementioned two petitions filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.78 dated 28.7.2010 under sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 201 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran.

Notice of motion order dated 15.11.2017 passed in CRM-M-42922-2017 reads in the following terms:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that earlier also, the petitioner was sought to be summoned on an application under Section 319 Cr.PC, but the said application was dismissed by the trial Court vide order dated 07.11.2015. Against the said order of the trial Court, the complainant preferred a revision petition, which was remanded back to the trial Court vide order dated 16.09.2016 passed by the revisional Court with a direction to record the statement of the complainant. It is on the basis of statement of the complainant, the petitioner has been summoned in the case vide order dated

06.06.2017 passed by the trial Court.

He further states that even otherwise, the alleged amount has already been paid to the complainant and the petitioner is ready to appear before the trial Court and to face the trial in accordance with law.

Notice of motion for 18.01.2018.

Meanwhile, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a week from today, he shall be admitted on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

The notice of motion order dated 11.12.2017 passed in CRM-M-46980-2017 reads in the following terms:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioners relies upon order dated 15.11.2017 passed by this Court in **CRM-M-42922 of 2017** titled as **Gurdeep Singh Versus State of Punjab.***

Notice of motion for 18.01.2018.

Meanwhile, in case the petitioners surrender before the trial Court within a week from today, they shall be admitted on bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

*To be listed along with **CRM-M-42922 of 2017.**”*

Counsel appearing for the petitioners has furnished before this Court certified copies of orders dated 15.12.2017 and 16.12.2017, which would reflect that the petitioners herein have already put in appearance before the Trial Court and have been admitted to interim bail.

Copies of order dated 15.12.2017 and 16.12.2017 are taken on record as Marks A and B.

Petitioners having joined trial proceedings, prayer made in these two connected petitions, is accepted. Orders dated 15.11.2017 passed in CRM-M-42922-2017 and dated 11.12.2017 passed in CRM-M-46980-2017, are made absolute.

Petitions disposed of.
