Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed reliance upon the order of the Coordinate Bench passed in **CRM-M-25468-2018** on 11.06.2018 to contend that no FIR can be registered in the offences under Mines and Minerals (Regulation of Development) Act, 1957. The petitioner is not named in the FIR.

Considering the seriousness of allegations levelled against the petitioner that he is indulged in illegal mining and perusing the detailed order dated 27.09.2018 of the trial Court mentioning the effect of illegal mining while rejecting his bail application, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the instant petition.
