The present petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 50 dated 03.02.2018, registered under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914 and 420 IPC at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

The petitioner was granted interim bail by the learned Sessions Court. However, the application for grant of anticipatory bail was ultimately dismissed as he has failed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has failed to join investigation on account of miscommunication between the petitioner and his lawyer.

It is very easy to state miscommunication after the relief sought for has been rejected. I can not believe that the date on which the petitioner was supposed to join the investigation was wrongly conveyed to him. Thus, there is no merit in this petition and the same is dismissed.
