This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. of petitioners namely Amit alias Sonu and Sunny in case registered by way of FIR No.10 dated 04.01.2018 at Police Station City Rohtak under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 354, 307 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 05.10.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from HC Bhoop Singh, Police Station City Rohtak who submits that the petitioners are no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered

from them and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 05.10.2018 is made absolute however, they shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. Thereafter, they will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
