The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.21 dated 21.1.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 323, 427, 186, 353, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Division No.7, District Commissioner Ludhiana.

Heard.

It is the case of the prosecution that on 20.1.2018, a police party had gone to recover contraband from one lady Aanchal who is the wife of Tony accused petitioner. However, the accused petitioner and his associates pelted stones on the police party and released Smt. Aanchal from the custody of the police. One lady constable suffered injury in that incident.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this

presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
