Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 5 to trace out the whereabouts of Neelam i.e. the daughter of petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that Neelam is missing since 04.09.2018, for which, a representation dated 07.09.2018 (Annexure P-1) has been given to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali i.e. respondent No.4, but no action thereof has been taken. She states that the petitioner, being father, is concerned about the whereabouts of his daughter.
