1. Vide order dated 08.12.2016, it was recorded that the complainant and injured may approach the Investigating Officer for making supplementary statement. If such statement is voluntarily made, it will be mandatory for the Investigating Officer to record the same as per mandate of Section 163(2) Cr.P.C.

2. The Investigating Officer was at liberty to file cancellation report on the basis of such supplementary statement.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajinder Kumar states that cancellation report has already been prepared and the same has been sent to Senior Superintendent

of Police, Gurdaspur for approval.

4. At this stage, no further action is called for.

5. This petition is dismissed as rendered infructuous.

However, petitioners may avail their legal remedies in accordance with law.
