Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, as husband of the petitioner is involved in FIR No. 215 dated 26.06.2018, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Division No.5, Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already given representation (Annexure P3) to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, in which, it is stated that her husband is falsely implicated in the case and police is harassing her and her family members.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that no such representation is received and police has visited the house of the petitioner only to arrest the accused/husband of the petitioner, namely, Ricky Singh and the petitioner or her family members are not required in the investigation of FIR and the police is not harassing them.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a representation to the concerned police official which may be dealt with in accordance with law.

Respondent No.4-SHO, Police Station, Division No.5, Ludhiana is directed that in case any of the family member of the petitioner is required for the purpose of the investigation of the case, a prior 07 days notice under Section 160 of Cr.P.C be given to the petitioner/her family members except accused/husband of the petitioner-Ricky Singh.
