ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL):

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as they are apprehending threats from respondents No.4 to 8.

A perusal of the petition shows that petitioner No.1 Mantu Khan has filed this petition with petitioner No.2 on the basis of the marriage certificate dated 05.09.2018(Annexure P3).

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Jagmail Singh, has submitted that petitioner No.1 has later on submitted an affidavit before the police authorities that he had filed the present petition seeking protection to them but after filing this petition, he has divorced petitioner No.2 Bimla Begum @ Bimla Rani as per the Mohammedan Law. It is

further stated in the affidavit that the petitioner No.1 do not want any protection and want to withdraw the present petition.

Learned counsel for respondents No.4 to 8 submits that petitioner No.1 is now residing with respondent No.4 Anwari Begum-his first wife.

In view of the same, the petition qua petitioner No.1 stands dismissed.

Without commenting upon the marital status inter se the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of petitioner No.2 with regard to any threat to her life and liberty and do the needful in accordance with law.
