Such kind of applications are to be filed before learned Illaqa Magistrate, who has primary control and supervision over the investigation and not before this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for respondent-Baljit Singh son of Gopal Singh has informed this Court that in this case, challan is stated to have been presented.

I am of the view that such kind of applications at the first instance should be filed before learned Illaqa Magistrate. Moreover, in this case, challan has already been presented. Therefore, if the petitioner wants to move appropriate application, he can move the same before the trial Court if so advised.
