Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for issuance of directions to take legal action on the representation (Annexures P-1 & P-2) against respondents no.5 and 6.

Pursuant to order dated 10.08.2018, Mr. Wazir S. Khaira, Superintendent of Police, Moga is present in Court.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Kesar Singh, PPS, D.S.P. (City), Moga, on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3 in Court, which is taken on record.

Learned State counsel while drawing the attention of this Court to the reply so filed submits that earlier, the petitioner had moved an

application against respondent no.5 before the police authorities, whereupon an enquiry was conducted by the official respondents and on conclusion of the enquiry, FIR No.90 dated 20.04.2018 under Sections 420/465/467/468/471 IPC, PS City South Moga has been registered against respondent no.5.

In view of the aforesaid stand of the respondents, the present petition no more survives.
