The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.261 dated 31.08.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Khol, District Rewari.

Heard.

It has been submitted that now a compromise has been effected and *CRM-M-44229-2017* has already been preferred for quashing the FIR. Statement of the parties have been recorded on 01.12.2017.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Manjeet son of Naresh Kumar is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned subject to following terms:-

(a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.

(b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.

(c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
