The petitioner had got FIR No.116 dated 22.08.2017 registered against the private respondents at Police Station, Division No.4, District Jalandhar, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 120-B and 34 IPC. Now, the said respondents are threatening the petitioner to coerce him into compromising the matter. Despite representation dated 26.09.2018 (Annexure P6), the police has not taken any action thereupon, till date.

Mr. K.S Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4. Let five copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon the private respondents, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P6) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
