Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Rakesh in case registered by way of FIR No.301 dated 23.07.2017 at Police Station Civil Lines, Sonipat under Sections 365, 376, 120-B IPC and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 06.10.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations as well as appeared before the trial Court and has been released on bail which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Devinder Singh, Police Station Civil Lines, Sonipat.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 06.10.2018 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions. The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
