In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.286 dated 26.06.2018, under Sections 307, 341, 427, 506, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Manimajra, U.T, Chandigarh.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner and complainant are blood related persons and petitioner is not involved in any other case and he has already undergone custody period of 3 months and 12 days. No purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bar as trial of the case would take some time.

3. Learned State counsel has produced custody certificate dated 10.10.2018. Same is taken on record.

4. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

5. In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner and complainant are blood related persons and petitioner is not involved in any other case and he has already undergone custody period of 3 months and 12 days and disposal of the trial will take sufficient time, I

deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

6. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner-Jasbir Singh @ Budhu is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.

7. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or other wise interfere with the fair trial.

8. Petition stands allowed.
