Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.73, dated 22.09.2017 under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Jalandhar.

The petitioner has been granted interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 06.10.2018. The relevant part of the said order is reproduced as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the complainant has given a cheque of ₹ 2 lakhs to co-accused Vijay Kumar on 25.09.2016 and the same was encashed by said Vijay Kumar. It is further submitted that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner that the complainant had handed over any amount to him. The only allegation against the petitioner is that he had introduced the complainant with Vijay Kumar.

Notice of motion for 16.11.2018.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Joginder Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the same, the order dated 06.10.2018 is made absolute.
