This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 171 and 379-A IPC at Police Station Sadar, Narwana, District Jind, vide FIR No.200 dated 01.08.2017.

FIR was registered on the complaint of Jai Parkash son of Raj Kumar. Allegations are that petitioners alongwith other co-accused came in a car without any number plate and snatched the bag containing Rs.1.00 lac from the complainant and fled away from the spot. Three accused were in police dress. Four co-accused namely, Satish, Yogeshwar @ Yogi, Pardeep and Kashmiri were arrested by the police, who have been released on bail.

Keeping in view seriousness of allegations, no case for pre-arrest bail is made out. FIR in question was registered on 01.08.2017. Interim bail was granted to the petitioners and taking advantage of this fact, petitioners have been trying to prolong the matter. The investigating agency has to

recover car as well as cash from the petitioners. In my considered view, custodial interrogation of the petitioners may be necessary to take the investigation to its logical end. Petition is without any merit and is hereby dismissed.
