Petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No. 74, dated 18.7.2018, registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 471, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Sadar Batala, District Gurdaspur. Petitioner was arrested on 18.9.2018. Challan has been presented in Court on 18.10.2018, in which charges are yet to be framed.

The police has filed reply by way of affidavit of Inspector Paramjit Singh, SHO, Police Station Sadar Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, in Court today and same is taken on record, in which it is stated that as per verification, a sum of Rs. 77,30,000/- out of Rs. 85,00,000/- has been returned to complainant.

In the bail matter, this Court is not required to comment on merits of controversy. In any case, if crime is proved against petitioner, he will have to face consequences for same.

Considering that all offences are triable by learned Magistrate and conclusion of trial will take time, there is no justification for further detention of petitioner. Petition is accordingly allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of trial Court, subject to following conditions :-

- (1) that petitioner will not leave the country without permission of trial Court ;
- (2) that petitioner will not give any inducement to witnesses acquainted with facts of case ; and
- (3) that petitioner will appear on each and every date of hearing in Court and on his absence, trial Court shall cancel his bail.
