The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.98 dated 28.9.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Verowal, District Tarn Taran.

Heard.

The petitioner has duped an amount of Rs.47 lacs for sending the complainant abroad. The petitioner represents that he was having hotels in Singalore and England.

Today, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not having any hotel in Singapore or England.

Today an offer was given to the petitioner to return the aforesaid amount of Rs.47 lacs but he refused.

Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the complainant has to prove from where he arranged an amount of Rs.47 lacs. To the mind of this Court, it is a matter of investigation and trial and also that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is necessary.

In view of the above, the petitioner is not entitled to the grant of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
