Above-referred petitions are being disposed of by this common order being connected to each other.

By way of Crl. Misc. No. M-43477 of 2017, petitioners Surjan Singh and six others are seeking quashing of cross version DDR No. 21 dated 14.09.2014, registered under Sections 323, 326, 452, 148, 149 IPC in case FIR No.169 dated 29.08.2014 under Sections 452, 323, 506, 427, 354, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Kmabo, Amritsar (Rural). Petitioners Harpal Singh @ Bhallu and four others had filed Crl. Misc. No. M-43481 of 2017 and are seeking quashing of FIR No.169 dated 29.08.2014 under Sections 452, 323, 506, 427, 354, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Kmabo, Amritsar (Rural) and consequent proceedings taken therein, on the basis of compromise.

Report has been received from the trial Court after recording statements of the parties on compromise. Trial Court has also sent copies of statements of parties recorded by it, which reveal that compromise is voluntary and without any pressure or coercion.

No useful purpose would be served to keep the FIR pending.

In view of the statements made by the parties and the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh & Ors. Vs. State of Punjab & Anr. 2007(3) RCR(CrL) 1052**, approved by Hon'ble the Apex Court in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab & Ors. 2012(10) SCC 303**, the instant petitions are allowed and the aforesaid FIR and the cross-version recorded therein and consequent proceedings conducted therein are quashed.

Needless to say that parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise.
