Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.307 dated 14.08.2018 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

While granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, following order was passed on 08.10.2018: -

“.....Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a lady, aged about 85 years. It is further submitted that as per allegations in the FIR, the agreement to sell pertains to the year 2008 and thereafter, neither the complainant side had got the sale deed executed nor any suit for specific performance was filed and even the period of limitation stands expired.....”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Gurpreet Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 08.10.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
