Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the complaint No.5088/2/2013 dated 16.08.2013 (P-8) registered under Section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act titled as “**Rakesh Sehgal vs. Neetu Narang**” pending before the Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Jalandhar and summoning order dated 03.10.2013 (P-10) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that he is not able to contact his client despite best efforts.
