By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass her or to compel her to produce her husband Manjit Singh against whom one FIR has been lodged.

Learned counsel submits that the petitioner has nothing to do with the allegations levelled in FIR No.109 dated 21.6.2018 under Section 306 IPC and Section 13 of the Travel Professional Regulations Act 2012, Police Station Division No.5, Jalandhar and is being simply harassed being wife of Manjit Singh, named in the FIR and the police is pressurizing her to produce her husband.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Station House Officer, Police Station Division No.5, Jalandhar (respondent No.3) to ensure that in case the

petitioner is required for the purpose of any inquiry or any information is to be elicited from her, then an advance notice in terms of Section 160 Cr.P.C. be issued to her and she being a lady be not unnecessarily harassed.

A copy of this order be sent to respondent No.3 so as to enable him to comply with the aforesaid directions.
