Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.76 dated 25.08.2017, under Sections 22/29/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station, Bhadson, District Patiala.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery of 50 vials of avil and 50 injections of Buprenorphine Hydrochloride (total 100 ml.) had been effected from co-accused Harjinder Singh.

There is no recovery that has effected from the present petitioner and she is sought to be implicated on the statement of co-accused.

Investigation in the case is complete, challan stands presented and the trial is at the initial stage.

Trial as such would take time to conclude.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI

Lakhbir Singh, Police Station Bhadson, Patiala concedes to the fact that the present petitioner is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

In view of the above, petitioner is held entitled to the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Patiala.
