On 20.11.2017, following order was passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court:-

“Notice of motion, returnable on 22.01.2018.

In the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail in FIR No.494 dated 14.10.2017, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 & 120-B of Indian Penal Code, Section 61 of Excise Act and Section 181 M.V. Act, at Police Station Dharuhera, District Rewari, on furnishing of his bail bonds amounting to ₹10,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. Petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when required and fully cooperate with the Investigating/Arresting Officer. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Thereafter vide order dated 22.01.2018, petitioner was again directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 30.01.2018 and to co-operate in the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that pursuant to the aforesaid orders dated 20.11.2017 and 22.01.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Subhash Chand admitted the aforesaid fact and stated that the petitioner is no more required in any further investigation of the case.

In view of above interim orders dated 20.11.2017 and 22.01.2018 are made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
