By this petition, quashing of FIR No. 76 dated 23.06.2012 is sought, registered against the petitioners at Police Station Udyog Vihar, District Gurugram, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioners and respondent no. 2, i.e. the complainant.

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Affidavits on behalf of the complainant-company, i.e. respondent no. 2 in these petitions, have already been filed, stating to the effect that the entire amount of Rs. 13,00,00,000/- (Thirteen crores) having been paid by the two petitioners in these two petitions, the complainant has no further grievance against the petitioners and no objection if the FIR itself is quashed.

Today, Mrs. Kiran Bala Jain, Advocate, has filed in Court her power of attorney on behalf of respondent no. 2 in these petitions, she earlier having filed a memo of appearance.

That being so and the matter having been amicably settled between the parties, with no further grievance left with the complainant, in the opinion of this Court, it would be pointless to continue with criminal proceedings, the parties having fully compromised the matter of their own free will.

Consequently, the petitions are allowed and FIR No. 76, dated 23.06.2012, registered against the petitioners at Police Station Udyog Vihar, District Gurugram, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
