Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to transfer the investigation being carried out by respondent No.4 in FIR No.75 dated 10.07.2018 under Sections 365, 323, 148 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station City-II, Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the aforesaid FIR has been registered against the petitioner at the behest of respondent No.6 Mohammad Anas. The brother-in-law (Jija) of respondent No.6 is President of Sikh-Muslim Foundation. The petitioner apprehends that the investigation could not be conducted fairly as the respondent No.6-complainant is well connected and has succeeded in getting the false case registered against the petitioner.

He further states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur is directed to consider the representation dated 26.09.2018 (Annexure P-3) made by the petitioner.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Surinder Pal Singh Tinna, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting anything upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the contents of representation dated 26.09.2018 (Annexure P-3) and to act in accordance with law.
