Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.26, dated 29.04.2018 under Section 379 of IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala.

The petitioner has been granted interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 09.10.2018. The relevant part of the said order is reproduced as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in fact, there is a civil litigation pending between the parties and uncle of the petitioner namely Banjara Singh had filed a suit for permanent injunction on behalf of Mandir Mata Seetla Rani against complainant Netar Singh and others. It is further submitted that even the name of the petitioner is wrongly mentioned in the FIR and the allegations against her are that she has stolen the amount from the cashbox of the mandir. Learned counsel further submits that since the matter is subjudice before the Civil Court, just to put pressure on the petitioner, present FIR has been registered without giving any details about the loss caused.

Notice of motion for 16.11.2018.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Krishan Lal, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the same, the order dated 09.10.2018 is made absolute.
