This petition has been filed under section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.207, dated 19.11.2014, under sections 406/419/420/465/467/468/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Navi Baradari, Jalandhar City, on the basis of compromise.

2. Pursuant to the order dated 04.05.2018, report dated 08.08.2018 of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, has been received in the connected case i.e. **CRM-M-46338-2017**. According to the said report, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise between the parties is genuine and has been reached between them out of their own free will and without any threat or coercion.
