The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case DDR No.4 dated 1.5.2016 registered under Sections 341, 324, 427, 323, 34, 325 (subsequently added) of Indian Penal Code in FIR No.49 dated 1.5.2016 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307 and 34 of Indian Penal Code and 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Goraya, District Jalandhar (Rural).

Heard.

Report of the learned Additional District & Sessions Judge received.

The petitioner was earlier granted bail by learned Magistrate vide order dated 8.7.2016 but he violated the terms of the bail by absenting himself from the Court proceedings, therefore, his bail bonds/surety bonds were cancelled and forfeited to the State.

Vide order dated 21.8.2018, the petitioner was ordered to be summoned through non-bailable warrants of arrest.

In this view of the matter and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court within seven days and on his doing so, he be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
