By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.50 dated 13.4.2007 registered under Sections 353/332/506/186/379/34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Chheharta, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

The petitioner had earlier been granted regular bail but on account of his absence on 11.10.2010, his bail was cancelled and subsequently he was declared a proclaimed offender on 14.2.2013. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that by now all other co-accused have since been acquitted and that in these circumstances, the petitioner may be granted anticipatory bail.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, I do not find any ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner especially keeping in view the long absence. However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the trial Court shall dispose of the same expeditiously preferably within a period of

two days thereafter while taking into account the fact that the co-accused have since been acquitted.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
