This petition has been filed seeking direction to respondents No. 2 to 5 to transfer the investigation of the case i.e. FIR 86 dated 04.08.2017 under Sections 323, 34, 406, 498A, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Women Nuh/Mewat, District Mewat to some other independent agency as the concerned police was allegedly not proceeding with the matter and not taking any action.

As per reply dated 03.04.2018 by way of affidavit of Sh. Sanjeev Balhara, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Firojpur Jhirka, it is specifically mentioned that on completion of investigation in the case, final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. was presented on 21.11.2017. Respondent No. 6 was arrested on 18.10.2017. Respondents No. 7 to 12 were found innocent during investigation and have been placed in column No. 2.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, no further orders are called for in this case. Needless to say, the petitioner is at liberty to avail remedy/remedies as may be available to him for redressal of

his grievance including that of the investigating agency not proceeding against respondents No. 7 to 12 and keeping them in column No. 2 of the challan.

Present petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
