The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in FIR No.56 dated 21.06.2018 under Sections 326, 325, 452, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated October 09, 2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ravinder Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

Memo of appearance filed on behalf of the complainant in Court today, is taken on record.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated October 09, 2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
