The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.51 dated 25th March, 2017, registered under Sections 302, 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station 'C' Division Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

2. The petitioner who is a women has remained in detention since 7th August, 2017.

3. Investigation in the case is already complete and challan submitted.

4. Perusal of the FIR goes to indicate that the only incriminating material against the petitioner is that she being the mother of the main culprit-Sunny was present along with others in the fateful feast in which the complainant's husband, father and brother had died consequent to their consuming liquor which was poisoned. But no other material apart from showing the presence of the petitioner in the concerned feast, as having been a part of any conspiracy appears to have been collected during investigation.

5. As such considering the long detention undergone by the present petitioner, namely Bhap @ Shashi, who is a woman, she may be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
