Present petition has been filed for seeking bail pending trial in FIR No.134 dated 30.11.2014 for the offence punishable under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in this very case, the petitioner was earlier released on bail. However, since on one date, he could not appear before the trial Court, therefore, his bail was cancelled. Thereafter, the petitioner is in custody since 08.01.2018. There is no other case against the petitioner.

On the other hand learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI Baljinder Singh, submits that since earlier also the petitioner had absented from the Court, therefore, he does

not deserve any concession. However, he does not deny that the petitioner was earlier released on bail and the fact that after re-arrest, he is in custody since 08.01.2018.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, but without commenting any further on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is granted the concession of bail pending trial. He be released on bail pending trial, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
