Petitioner-Gurmeet Singh has filed this second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.06 dated 04.02.2016, registered at Police Station Airport, District Amritsar, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the first petition filed by the present petitioner has already been dismissed on merit by this Court vide order dated 14.07.2017. It was specifically held in the said order dated 14.07.2017 that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation. Now at the time of arguments, no new facts have been shown for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Nothing has also been shown as to how the petitioner is now not required for custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the above facts and in view of the facts that the first petition filed by the petitioner has been dismissed on merit and no new facts have been shown for grant of anticipatory bail, I do not find any merit in the present petition.
