GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 3 dated 1.2.2016 under Sections 307, 34 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54 of Arms Act, Police Station Mallanwala, District Ferozepur and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 17.11.2017 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Zira has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners as

well as of Gurbachan Singh-complainant have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that Gurbachan Singh has no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been reported by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Zira that in his opinion the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (CrL.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition stands allowed and FIR No. 3 dated 1.2.2016 under Sections 307, 34 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54 of Arms Act, Police Station Mallanwala, District Ferozepur and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
