The petitioner alleges that she has been threatened and harassed by respondents No. 4 and 5 as they want to grab her share of land. They had filed two separate civil suits against the petitioner but the decision of the Civil Court has come against them. Yet, they are continuing with the harassment and despite representation dated 29.08.2018 (Annexure P-5), having been submitted before respondent No. 2, no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notice to respondents No. 4 and 5.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2 to objectively consider the representation dated 29.08.2018 (Annexure P-5) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case it is so felt necessary, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
