The petitioner seeks direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members as she apprehends that respondent Nos.4 to 8 would harm them.

It appears that the family of the petitioner has a long-standing dispute with the private respondents. The petitioner alleges that the private respondents had earlier assaulted the husband of the petitioner and her daughter in law and she had complained against them, but the police has not taken any action upon the complaint. Even now, they are being harassed by the police on account of their dispute with the private respondents.

Reply way of affidavit of Gurjit Singh, PPS, Asstt. Commissioner of Police (Gill-Rural), Ludhiana, has been filed, according to which, there is a property dispute between husband of the petitioner and respondent No.8 and there is no threat to the life and liberty either of the petitioner or of her family.

In view of the stand taken in the written statement, no direction can be passed in this petition except to direct respondent No.3 to ensure that

in case any future complaint is received from the petitioner regarding threat to her life and liberty, the same be enquired into seriously and it be ensured that no harm is caused either to the petitioner or her family members.

The petition is disposed of.
