Present petition under Section 482 Criminal Procedure Code
(‘Cr.P.C.’ - for short) has been filed for issuing direction to respondents
No.2 to 4 for registration of FIR against respondents No.6 and 7.

Affidavit of Mr. Suresh Arora, IPS, Director General of
Police, Punjab, Chandigarh has been filed in terms of order dated
20.3.2018, copy thereof has been supplied to the opposite side.

Perusal of paragraph No.9 of the affidavit reveals that during

the pendency of the present petition, FIR No.59 dated 28.3.2018 under Sections 406, 420, 193 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short) Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana has been registered on the basis of a complaint moved by the petitioner against Rajinder Pal Singh Walia and Sonam Walia.

In view of the above, the grievance of the petitioner is substantially redressed and no further directions are required in the matter, except that investigation be carried out in the above FIR as per law.

Needless to say that respondents No.6 and 7 may take all legal remedies available to them under the law regarding FIR No.59 dated 28.3.2018.
