Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.80 dated 04.02.2018 under Sections 307, 34, 109 IPC and Section 27 Arms Act registered at Police Station City Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is in custody since 04.02.2018 and during the course of investigation, the matter has been compromised between the parties. The injured - Surinder as well as complainant - Devender, who are brothers, have furnished affidavits to the effect that they do not want any legal action against the petitioner.

Mr. Karan Singh, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and filed his *vakalatnama* in Court, which is taken on record. He admits the affidavits so furnished on behalf of the complainant and injured.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajiv, submits that in the aforesaid case, the police has already concluded the investigations, charges have framed and the case is fixed for 04.12.2018.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that the complainant as well as the injured have come forward and furnished their affidavits in support the compromise, coupled with the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 04.02.2018 and trial will take sufficiently long time, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
