Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), District Gurdaspur, is directed to look into representation dated 28.09.2018 (Annexure P-3) moved by the petitioners, in a time-bound manner.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), District Gurdaspur, to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 28.09.2018 (Annexure P-3) after hearing the petitioners by passing a speaking order within a period of one

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month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
