In the instant petition, petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.193 dated 06.03.2018 under Sections 306/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Karnal, District Karnal.

2.) Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that unnecessarily petitioner has been implicated with reference to certain transaction between the petitioner's wife, petitioner and deceased and the transaction relates back to April, 2017, whereas statement of the deceased is dated 6.3.2018. Thus, petitioner has made out a prima facie case for anticipatory bail.

3.) Learned State counsel, on instructions has not disputed the above factual aspects. It is also submitted that petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation in the present case.

- 4.) Heard the learned counsel for the parties.
- 5.) In view of these facts and circumstances, petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the entire satisfaction of Trial Court/Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned subject to the following conditions:-
- (i) Petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and they shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.
- (ii) Petitioner shall surrender his passport in the Trial Court. In case he does not possess the same, in that event, he has to furnish an affidavit in the Trial Court to that effect.
- 6.) Petition stands allowed.
