The petitioners seek grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 48 dated 25.04.2018 registered under Sections 307, 324, 323, 341, 427, 148 & 149 IPC, at Police Station City Budhlada, District Mansa (P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the parties have compromised the matter and a quashing petition is pending. There is no injury which may be termed as dangerous to life and thus, the petitioners be released on regular bail.

Learned State counsel does not deny the fact that none of the injuries suffered by the complainant are dangerous to life. He however, submits that repeated attacks were made by sharp instruments on one of the injured person allegedly on his right leg and thus, the intention was clear.

It is apparent that the parties have reached an amicable settlement.

Thus, without opining on the merits of the controversy, it would be appropriate to release the petitioners on bail. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail on their furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned at Mansa.
