Though learned counsel for the petitioner has strenuously argued that the petitioner having been in custody for almost 1 year and 4 months, with the trial not progressing much, I am not inclined to grant him bail at this stage, in view of the fact that, firstly, he is shown to be a prime accused who is alleged to have shot the complainant in the abdomen with a country made pistol; and also looking at the other cases still registered against him, one of them being for the alleged commission of an offence punishable under Section 302 IPC and another one under Section 25 of NDPS Act, (though in three other criminal cases registered against him he has been acquitted).

Hence, the petition is dismissed at this stage.
