The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.55 dated 30.05.2018 under Sections 380, 457, 411 & 120-B of Indian Penal Code, Act No.45 of 1860, , registered at Police Station Bareta, District Mansa.

Heard.

The petitioners Jagtar Singh and Balam Singh were arrested on 13.06.2018 and are in custody since then. In this case, challan has already been presented and the charges were framed on 29.10.2018. The disposal of the trial will take its own time.

It being so, there is no ground for further detention of the

petitioners and accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- each with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court, subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) Petitioners shall surrender their passport before the trial Court, if any, and shall not leave the country without prior intimation to the Court;
- (2) Petitioners shall not directly or indirectly give any inducement or threat or promise to any witness and
- (3) Petitioners shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing before the trial Court and in case of his absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.

Accordingly, the petition stands allowed.
